The jury also loved the Höner backpack. "The Alpine Backpack Höner from Klättermusen consists of 100 percent Econyl, a nylon fiber made from recycled raw materials. But it is not only made sustainably - it is also particularly light, functional and indestructible." said the experts.

The Höner is an all-rounder that provides all the details that the mountaineer needs and is designed for extensive use in ski and alpine environments.
